

Portrait Gallery Bingo Card Set

Congrats on choosing a date at the National Portrait Gallery! Another excellent decision on your part. High five for adding a bit of flare to your love life. Your date will *definitely* appreciate it.

How This Card Set Works

Bottom Line. It's bingo, but custom-made for this museum! You will pick one of the bingo cards below and your date will pick the other one. In case you are unfamiliar with bingo, here are the rules:

1. If someone sees or does something in the Portrait Gallery that matches their bingo card, they cross it off.
2. The first player to get five boxes checked off in a row, either vertically, horizontally, or diagonally wins.

Easy, right?

Supplies: Two pens and two bingo cards – that's it! We're cruising now.
